Minimum certification standards as required by Canada Soccer, Ontario Soccer, and EMSA. AEL FC is committed to providing a safe, developmentally appropriate, and compliant soccer environment.

All coaches must meet the minimum certification standards outlined below before roster approvals.

These requirements are set by:

- Canada Soccer Association (CSA)
- Ontario Soccer (OS)
- Elgin Middlesex Soccer Association (EMSA)

Competitive Stream *Important Notes*

- Criminal Record Checks are subject to District and/or Ontario Soccer audit
- Coaches must select education courses matching the age group they coach
- Practical courses require Coach Centre registration
- All NCCP modules require a Coach.ca Locker Account
- Certification numbers or transcripts must be submitted to AEL FC
- Team rosters will not receive final EMSA approval until all minimum standards are met

Community Stream *Important Notes*

- Only the Coaching Soccer in Canada module is required (no practical course)
- Criminal Record Checks are subject to audit
- AEL FC is responsible for ensuring all Community Stream coaches meet requirements
- EMSA and/or Ontario Soccer may audit clubs for compliance
